Technical Tips

Pro-Mark™ II Markers

The Pro-Mark™ II Marker is an excellent and inexpensive choice for color repair of sanded through edges and coloring small scratches. It will quickly become an important color replacement tool for you to use. Care should be taken in the storage and usage of this unique product to maximize the marker's life, performance and your final results.

Pro-Mark™ II Markers look like, and in some ways, act like common magic markers, however they contain a special blend of colored dyes, solvents and resins that are designed to color, adhere and blend into a wide variety of finishes that are widely used on modern furniture and cabinetry. They are also formulated to stay in solution, which means that you don't have to shake the marker before use.

The Pro-Mark™ II Markers are gravity fed (capillary) like most magic markers, which means that in order to get fluid to the tip, the marker tip should be in a downward or slightly angled downward position. The marker will work in any position as long as it has fluid at the tip.

The best way to assure that the marker is ready for use is to store them on the shelf or in your kit with the caps firmly on and with the caps at the bottom.

In addition, the caps must be completely sealed to avoid air drying out the fluid at the tip. When replacing the cap on the marker, make sure that you hear it snap into position. This will assure that the cap is sealed

airtight and that the tip will be wet and ready to use when you remove the cap.

As a final tip, always be careful when removing the cap. The fluid under warmer environmental conditions may build up pressure that could result in excess fluid leaking from the tip into the cap. It is always a good idea to cover the cap with a cloth and remove in a twisting motion. If any excess fluid is in the cap it will be caught in the cloth and not on your client's floor.
